## ● Target students

Foreigners holding the TOPIK Level 2 certificate who are of age and residing in Korea.

- Must be able to understand and use TOPIK Level 2 grammar and vocabulary.
- Must possess basic listening and reading skills.
- Must be able to express their opinions in simple sentences.

## ● Course objectives

To reach a proficiency level where the student is able to pass the Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK) II Level 3 (120-149 points). The student should be able to converse in Korean in daily life, and perform basic language functions required in the use of various public facilities and maintaining social relationships. The student should be able to express or understand paragraphs on familiar and specific topics or societal issues of personal interest. The student should be able to differentiate the basic characteristics of written and spoken language, and understand and use these different forms of language.
