- Eligibility: International undergraduate students accepted for spring 2025
- Tuition: Free (fully funded by KAIST)
- Registration
 - Period: Jan. 10 to 17, 2025

- Learning Method
 - Korean grammar and vocabulary are studied independently through video materials.
 - Speaking and writing skills are developed through real-time sessions with experts.
 - Content studied via video materials is reinforced through 1:1 supplementary learning with a TA.
- Schedule
 - Camp Period: January 27 (Mon) February 21 (Fri), 2025
 - Daily Class
 - * Morning Classes: 3 hours of video lectures (You can watch the video lesson at your convenience, but it is mandatory to complete it.)
 - * Afternoon Classes: 4.5 hours of live online lessons, scheduled in Korean local time.
- Camp Completion Requirements
 - Attendance of at least 80%
 - Overall grade of 70% or higher (based on assignments, participation/attitude, quizzes, and midterm/final assessments)
