Course title: TOPIK Level 1

## ● Target students

Foreigners holding the TOPIK Level 1 certificate who are of age and residing in Korea.

- Must be able to solve questions of TOPIK Level 1 difficulty.
- Must possess basic listening and speaking skills (Can introduce oneself, and reply to questions such as “Where are you going?”, “What is this?”)
- Understanding of basic grammar and knowledge of the Korean language required.

## ● Course objectives

To reach a proficiency level where the student is able to pass the Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK) I Level 2 (140-200 points). The student should be able to use public facilities, and apply different forms of language to formal and informal situations. The student should have acquired about 1,500-2,000 words, and can enhance Korean language skills required for understanding and participating in university-level classes.
