## ● Target students

Foreigners holding the TOPIK Level 3 certificate who are of age and residing in Korea.

- Must be able to understand and use TOPIK Level 3 grammar and vocabulary.
- Must possess intermediate listening and reading skills.
- Must be able to understand not just everyday conversations but simple news articles and announcements.

## ● Course objectives

To reach a proficiency level where the student is able to pass the Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK) II Level 4 (150-189 points). The student should be able to conduct not just everyday conversations but simple social and official conversations as well. The student should be able to read news articles, advertisements, announcements etc. and understand the content. The student should be able to understand and use societal and cultural content based on their knowledge of frequently used colloquial expressions and key characteristics of Korean culture.
