Course title: TOPIK Level 1

## ● Target students

Foreigners who are of age and residing in Korea

- Basic knowledge of Hangul required. (Hangul consonants, vowels, syllables, batchim)
- Must be able to understanding basic words and sentences. (“저는 학생입니다. (I am a student)”, “이것은 책이에요 (This is a book)” etc.)
- Basic listening skills required.

## ● Course objectives

To reach a proficiency level where the student is able to pass the Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK) Level 1 (80-139 points). The student should be able to understand and use frequently used expressions in daily life and self introductions, as well as understand and express content related to personal and familiar topics such as oneself, family, hobbies, and the weather. The student should have acquired approximately 800 basic words and grammar to be able to form basic sentences.
